Sample E-Letter to Send to Family, Friends, Neighbors, and Others

With the election almost here, I wanted to touch base with you.

A reader in a popular website, Real Clear Politics recently said something that pretty well sums up my thoughts as well:

"Yes, President Trump's tweets are boisterous in nature and hurt him. Yes, he certainly has flaws. At least I know he will fight for my rights and has demonstrated a willingness to do so. That's why I'm voting for him. I can overlook everything else."

The way I see it this election is too important to let the candidates' personalities decide the outcome. I believe America is facing a crossroads. In one direction lies the traditional America you and I grew up in. In the other direction lies a rapid decline in the American way of life as we travel down the road toward socialism, and maybe something worse. In fact I think this is the most important election in our lifetimes. And that means the issues themselves are far more important than the candidates' personalities.

So let's look at a few key issues and see where each candidate stands.

JOBS AND THE ECONOMY

Before the Coronavirus struck, we had a record high stock market and record low unemployment. The economy was firing on all cylinders.

Under Trump, 401K plans have skyrocketed in value. That's partly because Trump cut income tax rates and slashed corporate tax rates. He also erased a lot of Obama-era regulations that were choking the economy.

Then came the Coronavirus, followed by the massive economic shutdowns which destroyed millions of American jobs and businesses.

Incredibly, the economy is bouncing back pretty rapidly. Yet Biden has promised to shut it down the moment some so-called expert tells him he should. If we've learned anything from the Coronavirus it's that the experts were wrong about as much as they were right.

So who do you trust more to rebuild the economy: Trump, who has already done it once, or Biden, who has already promised to raise taxes, replace gas and oil with solar panels and wind mills, and shut down the economy again?

I predict that under Biden our economy will sputter to a halt, the stock market will plunge, millions more Americans (perhaps some of our friends and neighbors) will lose our jobs, and our retirement savings could be wiped out.

SPEAKING OF THE CORONAVIRUS ...

I know Trump has been criticized for his response to the outbreak, and of course there are probably things he could have done better. But let's remember the pandemic is totally China's fault. No serious person disputes that the virus originated in China and that China allowed people from infected areas to travel to Europe and the United States.

Once confronted with the crisis, Trump acted decisively. He halted all flights from China on January 31, before even <u>one</u> American died. That action alone saved hundreds of thousands, and perhaps millions, of lives. Biden responded by insulting Trump and calling him "xenophobic," (although he later reversed himself and admitted Trump was right).

That episode tells me that if, God forbid, we're hit with another deadly pandemic, Joe Biden may once again put politics ahead of the public health, and millions could die.

Bottom line is that although Trump no doubt made some mistakes in handling the Coronavirus, overall, he did as well as possible under the circumstances, and Biden would have done much worse.

CRIME AND PUBLIC SAFETY

This is an easy one. Joe Biden and the Democrats did nothing and said nothing as violent, Marxist, anti-American groups like Antifa and BLM burned our cities (led by Democrats) to the ground, looted stores, and assassinated police officers.

Then they launched a movement to defund the police.

Trump, on the other hand, condemned the rioters from the start and, when Democrat big city mayors allowed it, he sent in the National Guard to restore law and order. What's more, nearly every major police group has endorsed President Trump, including some who don't usually endorse anyone. As far as I know, Biden has received zero police endorsements.

BORDER SECURITY

FOREIGN WARS

Joe Biden has supported plenty of foreign wars during his 47 years in office, including the War in Iraq. Trump, on the other hand, has repeatedly demanded an end to our "forever wars" in Iraq, Afghanistan and elsewhere. In fact, Trump has pulled most U.S. troops out of both countries, and the only reason any troops are still there is the Pentagon and other powerful forces are fighting him tooth and nail.

Trump has shown by actions he's the peace candidate, and Biden is the "forever wars" candidate. Where do you stand?

RACE RELATIONS

For 60 years now, Democrats have talked a pretty good game when it comes to lifting blacks out of poverty, but poverty, crime, illiteracy are far worse. Just look at every Democrat-run big city; they're all a mess.

Interestingly, race relations got worse, not better, during the Obama-Biden Administration. According to a New York Times/CBS poll taken 2016, at the end of Obama's second term, 69 percent of Americans felt that race relations were "generally bad," the highest number since the 1992 Rodney King riots in Los Angeles.

Fast forward to a January 2020 Gallup Poll, which found satisfaction with race relations jumped from 22 percent at the end of Obama's presidency to 36 percent under Trump.

And look at what blacks themselves are saying about Trump: A Rasmussen poll released on Friday (October 23) shows Trump's approval rating among blacks at 46 percent. As you know a lot of black celebrities and athletes have also endorsed Trump, and I predict he'll get a record share of the black vote on November 3.

ABORTION

I'm pro-life, and I do know most Americans agree on these two things: They are against late-term abortion (meaning after the baby is viable) and against taxpayer-funded abortion.
